GO Program Commercial & Industrial Energy Audit - Utility Program Description

<p>Primary Objectives</p>	<p>MMWEC’s Green Opportunity (GO) Program assists Massachusetts municipal utilities in developing and delivering energy efficiency services to their commercial and industrial customers.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide a streamlined process for the on-site review of electrical efficiency measures in existing commercial, industrial, governmental, and institutional buildings. • Assist eligible West Boylston Municipal Light Plant (WBMLP) C&I customers to reduce operating costs by identifying electrical energy efficiency improvements.
<p>Program Summary/Design</p>	<p>WBMLP C&I audit GO program will provide energy audit services ranging from scoping (walk-through) audits to ASHRAE defined Level 2. Audit services for customers will be initiated at the scoping audit level to identify potential measures for further analysis. The next step, if there is further interest on the customer’s part in pursuing additional analysis, would be to provide a focused audit on the measures identified in the scoping audit. This approach will provide for flexibility in the delivery of audit services, providing a focused report on efficiency measures having the greatest savings potential, while saving the cost associated with providing full facility level 2 audits.</p> <p>This program is for customers who would like to reduce their energy use but do not have an understanding of where they use the most electricity or are unfamiliar with the technology options available to save energy. Incentives through WBMLP are available to help defray the cost of the energy audit.</p> <p>Below is a detailed summary of the program process from project eligibility to final delivery of the incentive from WBMLP.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Audit Eligibility: Any commercial, industrial, institutional, educational, or municipal building, or in common areas of a multi-family building (> 4 units) in the service territory of WBMLP. 2. Application: The customer shall contact WBMLP to verbally request an audit and discuss their energy audit need with the light plant manager. The light plant will provide customer contact information upon approval to the GO Audit Team. A description of the types of audits available can be found on the WBMLP website or www.mmwecgoprogram.org 3. Audit Scope Development : After the customer receives verbal approval from the light plant manager and the light plant notifies the GO Audit Team, the customer will be contacted to further clarify the scope of the audit services needed. 4. Audit Scope Approval : The GO Audit Team will compile the information provided by the customer and present an audit scope and cost to the light plant manager and to MMWEC GO program administrators for discussion and approval. 5. Scheduling Site Visit : Following approval or approved revisions to the initial scope, the GO Audit Team will schedule a conference call with the customer and the light plant manager to review the approved scope and schedule the site visit. 6. Audit Cost Share Requirements: WBMLP will provide a cost share, to be determined, for audit services. Customer will be billed by the GO Audit Team for the remaining balance of the audit costs.
<p>Target Market</p>	<p>All non-residential customers – commercial, industrial, governmental, and institutional in West Boylston.</p>



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Target End Uses	All electrical end-uses in a customer's building or facility. Include all lighting, heating (if electrical), cooling, refrigeration, electrical water heating and industrial processes.
